## Northern Ice Awards Post-Regional Grants



Junior National Competitors Brad Kleffman, Michelle Fahrforth and Matt Kleffman were awarded post-regional grants for the 2004-2005 season. Brad and Matt each received \$850 and Michelle was given \$300 in her first year of membership. Congratulations to Brad, Matt and Michelle. These grants are another way of saying that Northern Ice is behind you all the way. Way to go!!!

Northern Ice is pleased to announce that **three** of our skaters, **Brad Kleffman, Michelle Fahrforth** and **Matt Kleffman** will be representing Northern Ice at Junior Nationals this year. All three earned the right to compete at Junior Nationals with their performance at the 2005 Upper Great Lakes Regionals Figure Skating Championships held October 5-9, 2004 in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

Brad Kleffman placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Juvenile Boys event at Regionals in his first season competing as a Juvenile. Brad trains at Rocket and Fox Valley Ice Arenas and is coached by Jodi Tipton.

Michelle Fahrforth and Matt Kleffman placed first in each of their compulsory dances and in the free dance event to earn first place overall and the opportunity to compete at Junior Nationals for the National Juvenile Dance title. Michelle and Matt are coached by Penny Knuth and Oleg Epstein.

2005 U. S. Junior Figure Skating Championships will be hosted by the Jamestown SC December 1-4, 2005 in Jamestown, New York. ## Club Ice and Ballet for Skaters

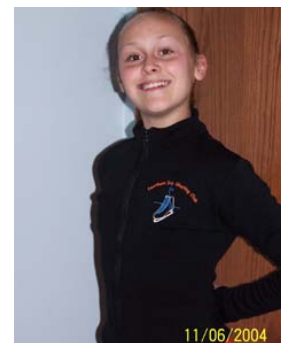
Northern Ice is excited to be offering club ice at Rocket Ice Arena on Sundays beginning Jan 2 from 1:30-2:30 at Rocket Ice Arena in Bolingbrook, IL. We will also be offering a ballet class for skaters taught by Ms. Naomi immediately following the ice time from 2:45-3:45. A contract has been posted on our website and included with this newsletter.

The contract is for 8 weeks. The cost is \$8.00 for 1 hr of ice for club members who contract. Walk-ons will be accepted for \$10.00 per session if space is available. We will be limiting the session to 20 skaters. The ballet class will be \$64.00 for 8 classes. We plan to offer this ice through May. Forms for the current session are due December 15. 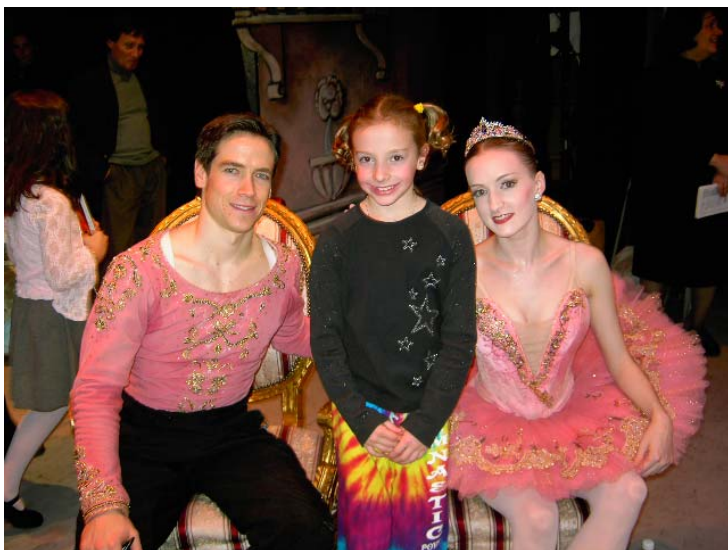
